Specialist Training

Thank you very much for your letter of 1st inst. requesting us to train your Mr. N.C.U Cooray in servicing our radar equipment.

However, our factory will be closed during most of July. Your suggestion to let Mr. Cooray arrive in Denmark in the third week of July, 1967, will therefore not be easy to meet. We therefore suggest the week from 6th to 12th August for the training.

We are also trying to arrange for training of our representative from Nigeria that week, and should therefore be pleased to have your prompt answer.

As to the allowance of dkr. 50,- per day we can inform you that our policy has changed since March, 1965, when our offer was sent to you. Instead of allowing that amount we are now paying for the board and lodging during our service representatives' stay with our company. This will amount to about the same amount and there will consequently be no difference to your technician.


