Dear Sirs,

We thank you for your letter of the 21st March, and as requested enclose herewith a copy of the Service Agency Agreement.

We have today discussed the situation in Ceylon with Mr. Unstead and he has reported on his conversation with Mr. Motha in Colombo. Whilst we are pleased to hear from your letter that your work is back to normal and that you have engaged a new staff of engineers we feel that you must be lacking radar trained men and will not, therefore, be able to provide satisfactory radar service.

In order to assist you and so that we may assess the ability of your engineers we are sending our engineer Mr. J.N. Pope from Djakarta to Colombo, where he will arrive on or about the 8th April. Mr. Pope will stay with you for about ten days and will instruct as many engineers on Decca equipment as possible in this short period.

Please give Mr. Pope every facility and when he returns to London and we have discussed his visit with him we will be in a better position to decide if it will be necessary to ask you to send someone to us for more extensive training.

We trust that the troubles you have so frankly reported to us will soon be overcome.

8th Nov. to 12th Nov.	1965	Arkas automatic pilot equipment.
